

Declaration of Decontamination

- For the protection of our employees and facilities as well as due to legal regulations (e.g., § 71 of the German Radiation Protection Ordinance (*Strahlenschutzverordnung*), §§ 16 + 17 of the German Hazardous Substances Ordinance (*Gefahrstoffverordnung*), § 19 of the German Chemicals Act (*Chemikaliengesetz*), EU regulation no. 1907/2006 (REACH), Genetic Engineering Safety Ordinance and Bio Substances Ordinance of 21 July 2021 (*Bundesgesetzblatt I*, pg. 3115)), we require that you complete and sign this declaration of decontamination.
- The document is presented to the responsible service department or on-site technician together with the product, or, if returned, is affixed to the outside of the packaging protected from moisture in a clearly visible manner. Deliveries without this form will not be processed and will be sent back, postage unpaid, to the sender.
